The inspirational artwork created by some of the most dedicated teen artists from across the state of New Jersey will be on view at the **The Noyes Arts Garage of Stockton University** from November 11 – December 28. The artwork on display is part of the 2017-18 State Teen Arts Touring Visual Art Exhibition curated by the New Jersey State Teen Arts Festival. **The Noyes Arts Garage of Stockton University** is located at 2200 Fairmount Ave, Atlantic City, NJ 08401.

The 2017-18 State Teen Arts Touring Visual Art Exhibit features the nominated paintings, drawings and photographs created by the most dedicated arts students across the state. The students' Home Counties nominated 20 pieces of student art work to be showcased for display at the 2017 New Jersey State Teen Arts Festival this past May and June. Four (4) student art works were nominated by each county to be part of the State Teen Arts Touring Visual Art Exhibit. These 45 art pieces featured in the New Jersey State Teen Arts Touring Visual Art Exhibit were selected from among thousands of pieces of artwork showcased from 15 different counties: Atlantic, Bergen, Burlington, Cape May, Cumberland, Essex, Gloucester, Hudson, Mercer, Monmouth, Ocean, Salem, Somerset, Sussex, and Union.

**Four Atlantic County students were selected to be the representatives of Atlantic County** for the New Jersey State Teen Arts Festival's 2017-18 State Teen Arts Touring Visual Art Exhibit, **they are as follows:**

**Rebekah Betar** from *Cedar Creek High School*, **Sabrina Singh** from *Egg Harbor Township High School*, **Ava Keuhner** from *Ocean City High School*, and **Claire Bustos** from *Oakcrest High School*.

The tour launched on July 20<sup>th</sup> at the Bergen Performing Arts Center and will continue traveling through May 2018 ending the tour at the Jay and Linda Grunin Center for the Arts at Ocean County College just in time to kick off the 2018 New Jersey State Teen Arts Festival on May 30<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup>, & June 1<sup>st</sup>.

Registrations are now being accepted for the New Jersey State Teen Arts Festival. All New Jersey students and teachers are invited to attend. In addition to a spectacular celebration of the arts, teachers can partake in professional development workshops and students can take master class workshops and explore a college fair. Additionally, all students and teachers are welcome to observe the showcase performances and art displays. All schools must complete and submit a school registration prior to attending the Festival.
