3. Artwork must be framed and wired, ready for hanging.
4. Two works may be submitted. However space may be limited to one piece (gallery discretion)
5. Work must be picked up at the gallery on Monday, October 29th
6. Accepted mediums: acrylic, oil, watercolor, pastel, and drawing
7. Artists are asked to capture the beauty of the Atlantic County Parks. See map of permitted locations.

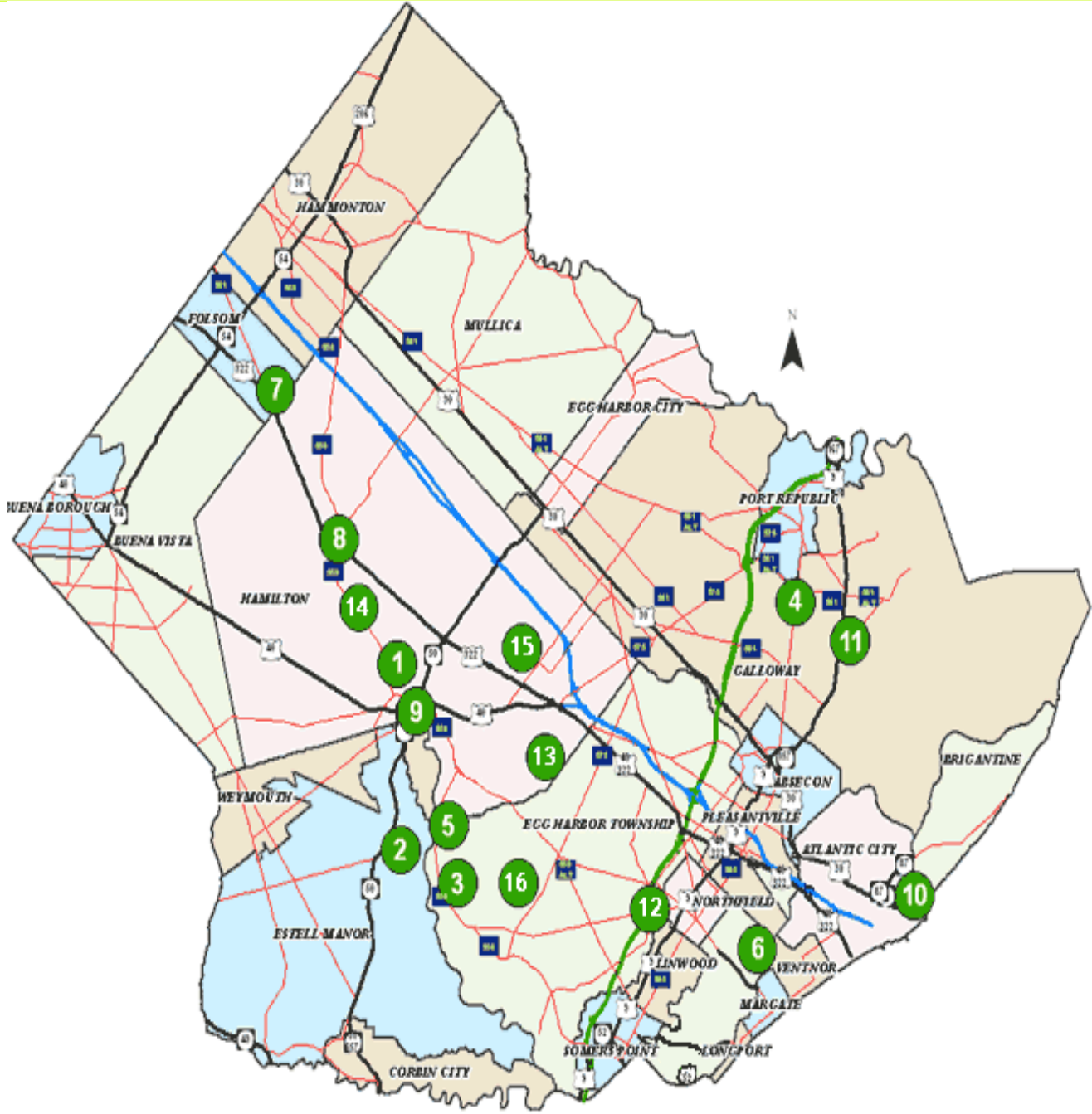
