REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMISSION

1. Standard size canvas/paper – 5"x7" to 16"x20".
2. Canvas/paper will be stamped at time of check-in. Registered artists may paint after check-in. Return work no later than 6:30PM.
3. Artwork entered must be framed and wired, ready for hanging.
4. Two works may be submitted. However space may be limited to one piece (gallery discretion).
5. Work must be picked up at the gallery the week beginning Monday, December 2nd.
6. Accepted mediums: oil, watercolor, acrylic, pastel, and drawing.
7. Artists are asked to capture the beauty of the Atlantic County Parks. See map of park locations.

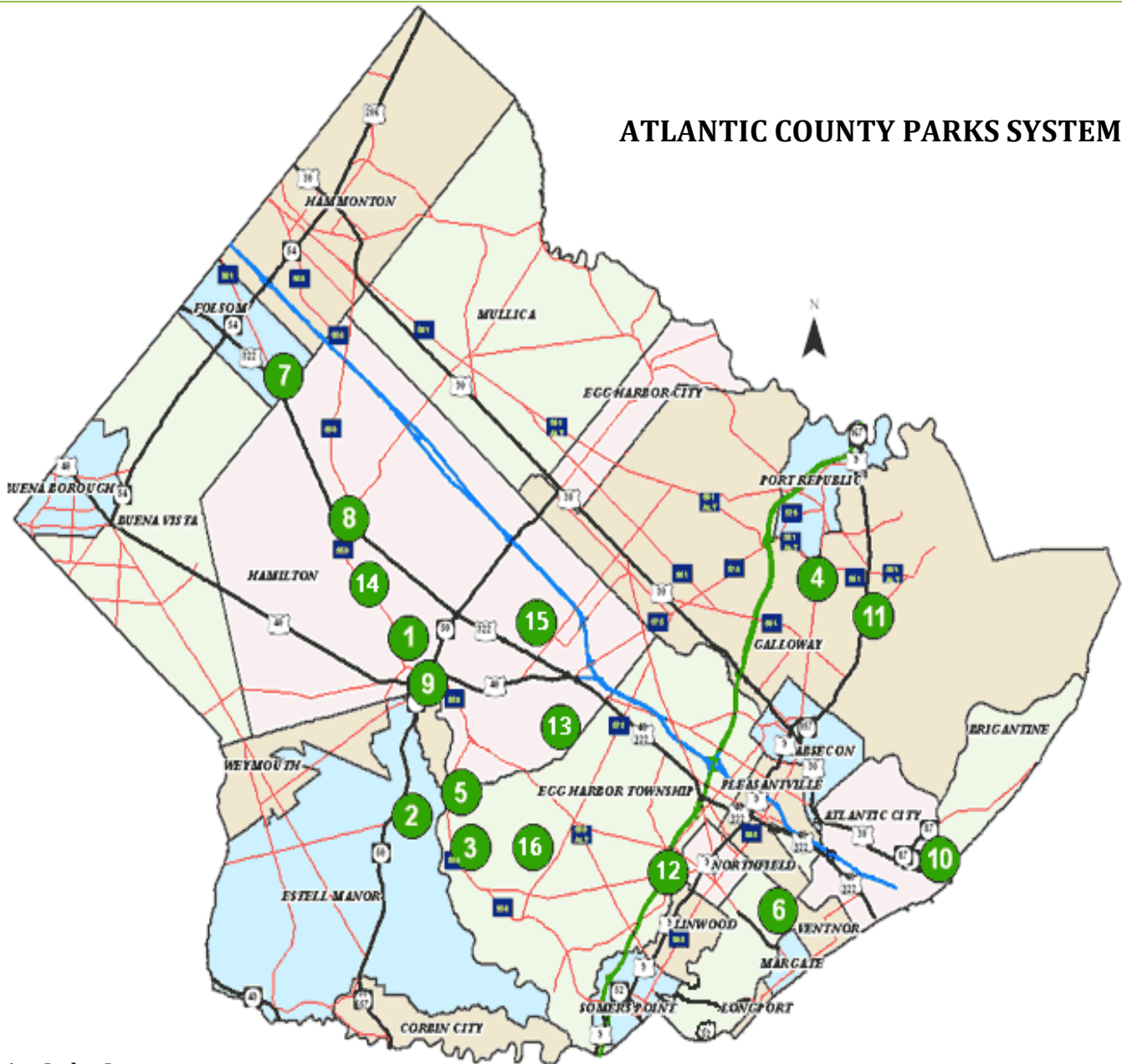
