DIRECTIONS TO ATLANTIC COUNTY OFFICE OF EDUCATION

From Atlantic City:

Follow US 40 West approximately 21 miles to Atlantic County Route 559. Turn right on Route 559. ACOE is 2/10 mile on the right.

From Atlantic City Expressway:

Take Exit 12 and follow signs to Mays Landing/US 40. Follow US 40 West approximately 7 miles to Atlantic County Route 559. Turn right on Route 559. ACOE is 2/10 mile on right.

From Trenton:

Take US 206 South to US 30 East at Hammonton; make a left onto US 30 East and travel approximately 10 miles to Egg Harbor City to NJ Rt. 50; make a right onto NJ Rt. 50; travel 6.8 miles at which point NJ Rt. 50 merges with US 40 West; proceed on US 40 West for 1.4 miles to Atlantic County Rt. 559; turn right onto Rt. 559; Atlantic County Office of Education is approximately 2/10 mile on the right.

From Garden State Parkway:

Take Exit 38B to Atlantic City Expressway (West). *Follow Atlantic City Expressway directions above.
