Prevent serious health issues such as MIS-C**



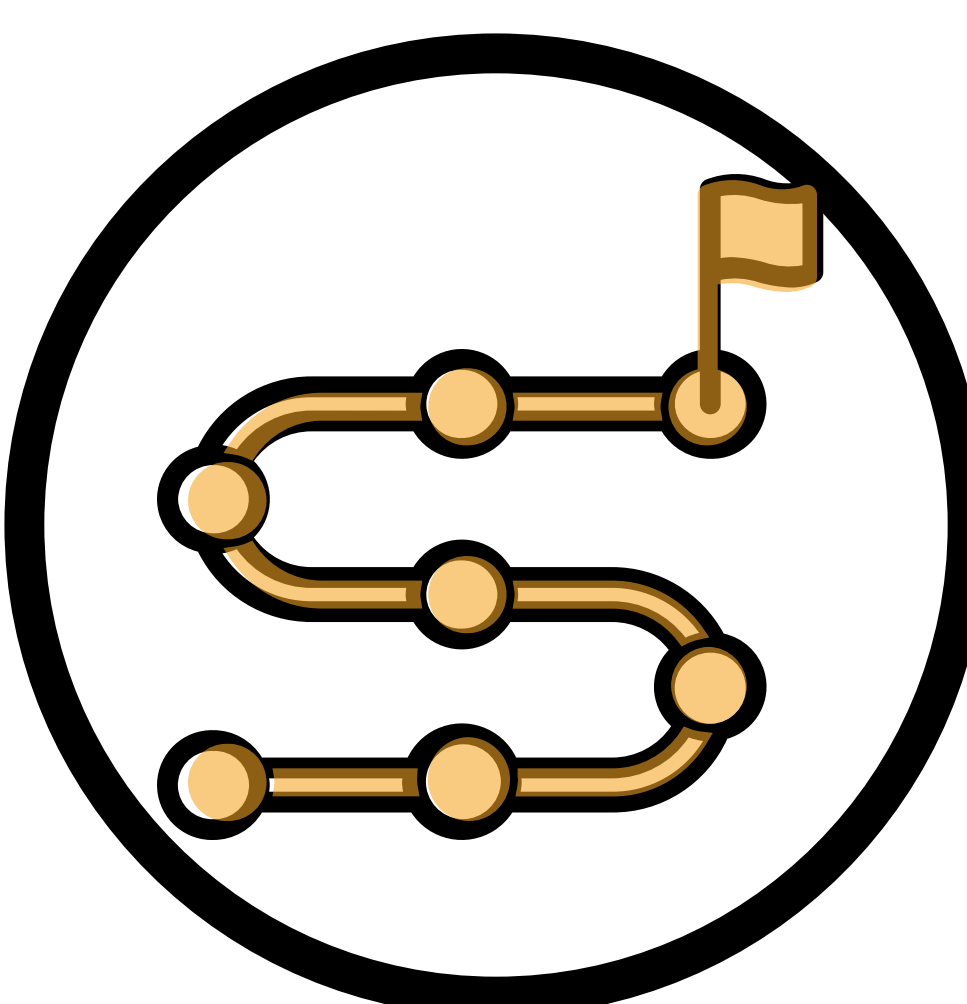
Keep kids in school for in-person learning
