## **KNOW THE FACTS:**



#### **Before going out:**

- · Wear light colored clothing, tuck shirt into pants and pants into socks.
- Wear closed shoes.
- Apply a tick repellent and follow product directions—for children consult your pediatrician.



#### **While Outside:**

- Stay in center of trails.
- Avoid low bushes and leafy brush.
- Periodically check clothing and skin for ticks and remove them.



#### **Upon Return:**

- Check clothing, skin and hair for ticks.
- Check pets for ticks after each time they are out.
- Promptly remove any ticks carefully with tweezers.
