## Temporary Mooring Information

- Temporary mooring is permitted between April 1<sup>st</sup> and November 30<sup>th</sup> of each year.
- Temporary mooring permits are valid for ten days; permits expire at sunset on the tenth day of mooring. It is the permittee's responsibility to ensure the permit sticker is current. If it expires and not renewed the permittee will be subject to enforcement action.
- Permits shall be affixed to the upper corner of the starboard side of the stern to allow for easy viewing from the bulkhead.
- Permittees must remove their boats for a period of twenty-four hours before registering for another ten day permit.
- At each expiration time the permittee is required to remove any lines, weights, floats, buoys, or hardware from the bulkhead. The County takes no responsibility for equipment not removed after the permit has expired. Any equipment not removed is subject to confiscation by The County.
- Temporary mooring is permitted only in designated areas.
- Exchanging of sites with other mooring patrons during the ten day period is prohibited
- The regulations on temporary moorings apply to vessels that make use of the bulkhead to secure the vessel overnight.
- Temporary mooring sites will be assigned by the Parks Division on a first-come, first-served basis. There are no guarantees of site based on any previous permit sites.
- The Division of Parks and Recreation will under no circumstances provide assistance in the placement of any anchoring gear or lines.
- It should also be clearly understood that the bulkhead area, although patrolled, carries no 100% guarantee for security. The Division of Parks and Recreation maintains no responsibility for equipment or gear left on board the boats anchored at the bulkhead, or any damage incurred as a consequence of temporary mooring at the site.
- It is required that permittees keep their contact information up to date at the Parks and Recreation Reservation Office located in the Boathouse at Lake Lenape (6303 Old Harding Hwy [*GPS address: 6126 Old Harding Hwy*], Mays Landing, NJ 08330, 609-625-8219.)
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on any vessel while anchored or tied at the Gaskill Park Bulkhead.
- Swimming is prohibited from the Gaskill Park Bulkhead and any vessel anchored or tied to it.
- Ordinance items not covered by this policy are still in effect and the permittee is responsible for being compliant with them.

## PLEASE NOTE STATE STATUE:

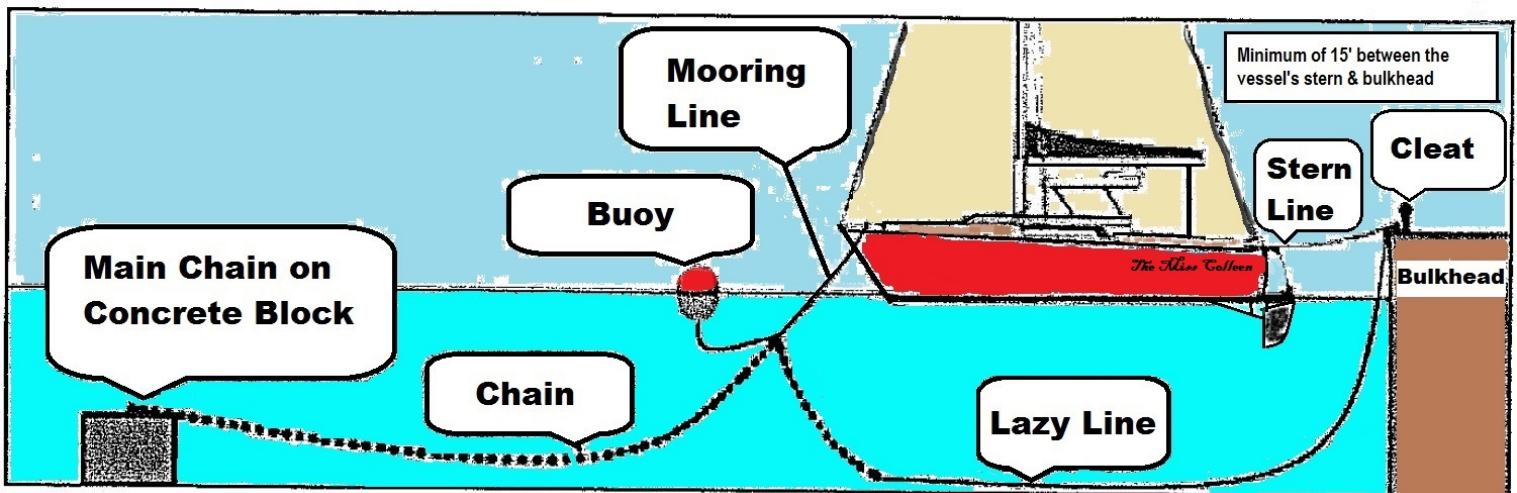
### 12:3-58. Declared a nuisance

The mooring, grounding or otherwise attaching or fastening of a boat, barge or raft to or upon the riparian lands of the state and permitting the same to remain so for a period of ten days shall constitute a nuisance.

### 12:3-59. Misdemeanor

Any person who shall willfully moor, ground or otherwise attach or fasten, or authorize, cause or permit to be moored, grounded or otherwise attached or fastened, any boat, barge or raft to or upon the riparian lands of the state, for a period of more than ten days consecutively, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

## Temporary Mooring Instructions



1. All vessels shall be anchored with the stern to the bulkhead and the bow secured to the vessels anchor.
2. There shall be a minimum distance of 15 feet between the stern of the vessel and the bulkhead.
3. Vessel anchors should be of such a weight as to ensure that the vessel is held in position at all times.
4. The permittee is responsible for maintaining the vessel in the proper position.
